1 Introducing the survey

Aims of the survey

The Coronavirus pandemic has a worldwide impact. The health of many inhabitants is at stake, but the world of work is also heavily affected. Statistics of the World Health Organisation and national related institutions provide overviews of developments in the health situation. However, for work-related issues monitoring instruments are lacking, though these are urgently needed. Given its online infrastructure, WageIndicator is to a certain extent able to provide such monitoring. Unfortunately, it is not possible to undertake a representative global survey through samples drawn from national populations but the infrastructure of the WageIndicator allows to undertake a volunteer web-survey. Thus, we have developed a global web-survey with questions such as:

- Is your work affected by the Corona crisis?
- Are precautionary measures taken at your workplace?
- Do you have to work from home?
- Has your workload increased/decreased?
- Have you lost your job/work/assignments?

On March 30, 2020, WageIndicator officially launched the survey through press releases and a range of social media activities. Its partners supported the launch by using their own channels.

This codebook describes the details of the survey.

A volunteer, anonymous, global, continuous, non-commercial web survey

Web survey WageIndicator is a non-profit foundation, aiming to share and compare wages and labour law on a global scale through its national websites in 150 countries with millions of web visitors.¹ Web visitors are primarily people in working age, contracted, self-employed and unemployed alike. For many years, WageIndicator conducts global web-surveys, and was therefore capable of launching quickly a global web-survey on Living and Working Conditions in Corona-virus times. The survey was developed for 143 of these 150 countries. Seven countries were not included, due to poor Internet penetration or a lack of translation capacities. Volunteer WageIndicator's web visitors are invited to complete the web-survey on Living and Working in Corona Times. Hence, this is a volunteer survey; the survey data do not allow to draw conclusions about the population at large. This method may lead to some overrepresentation of people looking for labour market information by browsing the Internet. This may be the case for people losing their job or working from home. Others may in particular be invited by promotion campaigns using social media. Press releases and promotion via stakeholders can also improve response rates.

Anonymous The questionnaire contains no questions regarding name, address, email or social media names of respondents. IP numbers are encrypted. The survey data therefore cannot be used to identify a single individual by name.

Global Across countries the survey asks the same questions. WageIndicator's online research infrastructure is built up over the past two decades and is equipped to conduct global web-surveys. The survey data is stored on one server and results in one dataset including all countries surveyed.

Continuous The web-survey is continuously posted on the national WageIndicator websites and will be continued as long as the Coronavirus pandemic lasts. The resulting observations over time allow to study the impact of context variables. For example, another WageIndicator survey, that on salaries has for example been used in a study on the impact of macroeconomic fluctuations on life satisfaction.

Non-commercial The survey has no partners with a commercial interest in the data.

Recruitment to the survey

In four ways respondents are recruited to the survey. First, web visitors to the national WageIndicator websites are invited to complete the survey by means of teasers on many web pages. In 2019 the websites received in total 47 million web visitors. For many years WageIndicator has proven to be capable of attracting massive web traffic by means of search engine optimization, social media activities, posting teasers on the webpages, and alike.

Second, in all national websites WageIndicator has prepared web pages related to the Corona-virus and work.³ These pages have content for Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) regarding work-related issues with answers based on national labour legislation. This content will provide matches for web users who search in search engines for words related to corona-virus and work, and thus will attract web traffic. Note that WageIndicator is experienced in search engine optimization. The pages of course include links to the survey and they include daily updated infographics showing the results of the survey, see for example the UK website for maps and graphs.⁴

Third, WageIndicator team members will undertake recruitment through social media in their respective countries. For this outreach brief video's have been prepared.

Fourth, partners of WageIndicator will recruit respondents through their own channels, such as Newsletters, postings on their web sites, twitter messages, and alike. WageIndicator has a strong tradition of cooperation with reputed academic institutions around the world. Through this tradition research has been facilitated in disciplines like sociology, psychology, economics, and web-based data collection methods. WageIndicator has collaborated with stakeholders in the world of work and has successfully participated in calls for proposals at national and international levels. WageIndicator has been partner in EU-funded FP6, FP7 and Horizon 2020 projects and is currently a community partner in the Social Sciences and Humanities in the European Open Science Cloud ([SSHOC](#)) project.

The data collection

On March 15, 2020, WageIndicator received an email from a partner whether it could launch a survey to trace work-related developments regarding the Coronavirus. Within a few days the questionnaire had been designed, the software programmed, the webpages built, the survey and the web pages translated and the survey tested. By March 23, data of the first questionnaire had been entered into the dataset and by March 28, 310 respondents from 39 locales (language_country) had already completed the survey. Most respondents had been recruited through the WageIndicator teams. The official launch took place on March 30, and it may be expected that from then on many more respondents from many more countries will complete the survey.

The data will be used for two purposes. First, the results will be used to present daily updated infographics on the national WageIndicator websites. Second, the data is available for researchers. WageIndicator and associated researchers plan to produce a report with descriptive results of the survey; an exploration of the impact of the Coronavirus on respondents' life satisfaction; a tool to translate respondents' comments on the survey in English; an analysis of the household composition and the presence of a pet, and more.

Data for research

Countries and languages in the survey

The survey is posted on the national WageIndicator websites of 143 countries, of which 12 countries have two languages, e.g. Belgium, Switzerland, and USA. This results in 157 locales (language by country). The survey in these 157 locales cover in total 38 languages. Most common is English (40 locales), followed by French (26 locales) and Spanish (22 locales), Arabic (18 countries), Russian (7 locales) and Portuguese (6 locales). Note that the survey has country adaptations for the same languages if needed, e.g. language differences between Portugal and Brazil are addressed.

The initial questionnaire has been drafted in English, and then translated in 37 languages. Being native speakers, WageIndicator team members could provide the translations for 22 languages. The remaining 15 languages have been translated by the translation agency [OneHourTranslation](#), with whom WageIndicator has a long-lasting relationship.

2 The design of the questionnaire

Introduction

This section details the initial questionnaire requirements, the six pages of the web survey, the use of API's (Application Programming Interface), and the variables.

- Appendix 1 lists all questions and answers, their IDs and their routings.
- Appendix 2 lists all variables from the questionnaire as well as all variables generated from data in the questionnaire
- Appendix 3 lists the countries with a survey.

Questionnaire requirements

The survey aimed to target a wide audience with various skill levels and readability capacities. Therefore, the questionnaire had to be easy to be *understood* and brief enough to reduce the chance of dropout due to not-understood questions. The questionnaire needed to be multilingual.

To allow analyses of the data the answers to the questions needed to be numerical. However, for a topic that digs so deep into anybody's personal life as the Coronavirus does, respondents may want to enter their personal opinions and worries. For this purpose a text box has been added at the end of the questionnaire. [SSHOC](#) partner [CUNI](#) - Institute of Formal and Applied Linguistics, Charles University (Czech Republic) will apply its translation tool to provide English translations of the comments in the text box, so that they can be analysed.

All questions in the survey are compulsory apart from the very last question where respondents can add comments.

The questionnaire includes routing to ensure that no questions are asked to respondents to which the questions do not apply, e.g. respondents who have no job and who never have had a job are not asked questions about Coronavirus measures taken by the employer.

Six pages

The questionnaire consists of six pages:

PAGE_intro This page has an introductory text and a consent question

PAGE_personal This page has questions about residence region, gender, country of birth, and education

PAGE_job This page has questions about having a paid job, ever had so, employment status, occupation, whether the job was affected by the coronavirus and if so, how, whether measures had been taken at the workplace, job-related expectations

PAGE_household This page has questions about number of persons in the household, if more than one who lived in the household, number of rooms in the household, children and year of birth of children, whether the children had to stay at home due to the coronavirus, and opinion about the corona crisis

PAGE_diagnosis This page has questions whether respondent had been tested for the virus, recently suffered from coronavirus symptoms, whether family members, friends or colleagues at work had been diagnosed with the corona virus, and how respondent would rate his/her health.

PAGE_end This page has a question of life satisfaction and a text box for inviting respondents to comment upon Living and Working in Coronavirus Times

API's for measuring region, education and occupation

For many years WageIndicator has been conducting continuous, multi-country surveys. To measure so-called long-list questions about education, region, occupation or industry, WageIndicator has developed API's for its surveys. Three API's have been used in the survey.

One API contains the national educational categories in the national language relevant in the country surveyed, so that all respondents can answer the education question in their own language. A bridging variable is available that converts the national educational categories into the standard ISCED-1997 classification.

One API contains a list of approximately 1,700 titles for respondents to self-select their occupation, using text-string matching. A bridging variable is available that converts the occupational titles into the standard ISCO-08 classification.

One API contains a 2-steps tool, that allows survey respondents to identify their province or state in the first step and cities therein in a second step. For European countries, a bridging variable is available into the standard NUTS classification. Other bridging variables indicate whether the province or state includes the country's capital city, or the population size of the city in size groups.

Variables

The questionnaire results in 73 variables, of which 72 are numerical and 1 is alphanumerical. In addition, another 48 variables are generated from the survey. This includes variables indicating year, month, week, and day of survey completion, variables generated from the API's as explained above, variables including the time stamps for each page in the questionnaire, and variables indicating the device of the respondent.
